It is foreseen the electric supply of 2 kw mono power upon payment (Form B) and exclusively in the established areas (see layout). Exhibitors can use their own power generating sets only if silent and in accordance to existing laws, and takes responsibility of all the machines turned on and other furnishings placed within its own exhibiting area (engines, structures, banners, flags and other advertising pieces)

FIELD AREA : Areas of a minimum of 80 sqm, available exclusively for dynamic demonstrations of any type of products and machinery, as per art. 12 of the General Terms & Conditions and of the Demonstrations Rules (See Form C). Electric supply not available in this area. Exhibitors can use their own power generating sets only if silent and in accordance to existing laws, and takes responsibility of all the machines turned on and other furnishings placed within its own exhibiting area (engines, structures, banners, flags and other advertising pieces)

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. DENOMINATION AND ORGANISER

The event *Forest Wood Energy 2011* , in acronym "*FORLENER 2011*" (hereinafter "Exhibition") is organised by PAULOWNIA ITALIA SRL (hereinafter "Organiser").

2. VENUE – DATE – OPENING HOURS – ACCESS

The Exhibition will be held from September 23rd to September 25th, 2011, at Biella Fair Centre, Gaglianico (BI), Italy. Opening hours for visitors will be non stop 9.00 - 18.00 for the whole period of the Exhibition. Exhibitors and their staff may enter the pavilions starting from 8.30 and must leave them before 18.30. Access to the Exhibition is open to the public upon payment of an entrance ticket. If needed, the above opening hours may be altered at the will of the Organiser.

3. SUBJECTS ALLOWED

In order to safeguard the specialised nature of the event, exhibition is allowed solely to products, appliances and services listed in the page named "Subject Groups"

4. EXHIBITORS ALLOWED

All Italian and international producers, directly or through their representatives, all distributors, institutions, associations and other public or private bodies operating in the sectors indicated in Art. 3 may be admitted to the Exhibition

5. REGISTRATION FEE – FEES FOR REPRESENTED BRANDS – RENTAL FEE FOR FLOOR AREA – BASIC SERVICES INCLUDED

Excepting the cases – determined at the will of the Organiser – of institutions, associations and other non profit public or private bodies fostering the sustainable exploitation of wood from forestry, agro- forestry and agricultural resources, admission to the Exhibition for exhibitors is subject to the payment of a Registration Fee. The amount is indicated in the Application form. Such charge covers: a) insertion, with standard space as indicated in the specific form, in the Exhibitor's Catalogue; b) Web listing in the Exhibition's site, for at least two years or until the next edition of the exhibition, in standard space c) two copies of the Exhibitor's Catalogue; d) stand cleaning before the official opening (during the exhibition, the cleaning service of the stands is at the Exhibitor's expense); e) insurance coverage for general third-party liability of the Exhibitor, with the maximum sums payable and the conditions stated in Art. 16; f) Advertising tax within the stand, according to the conditions outlined in Art. 15; g) supply of technical services, according to the conditions specified in the Application form.

Exhibitors representing and/or promoting the image of other brands must, in addition, pay a Registration fee for each company represented/promoted. The amount is indicated in the Form A of the Application form. Should a non-registered company be found to be displayed or promoted in its products or services, will be charged a sum equal to the Exhibitor's Registration Fee.

Exhibitors are also granted free parking spaces in the unattended car parking lot, subject to availability (the Organiser declines any liability for theft or damages to vehicles inside this area).

6. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE AND ACCEPTANCE

In order to participate at the Exhibition, it is necessary the submission of the Application Form (Form A) duly filled and signed for acceptance of Terms and Conditions. Submission has to be made within the specified deadline. Only Application forms duly filled in and signed according to the present Regulation, accompanied by a copy of the bank transfer of the amount due and the other documentation required (eventually Form B), will be accepted. The Registration form constitutes for the applicant an irrevocable contract of participation.

Acceptance of the Registration form shall be given by the Organiser only in case of compliance with the requirements in Art.s 3 and 4 and will be formally communicated by issue of the Notification of stand allocation. Acceptance of the Registration form shall bind the applicant to: a) accept the present General Terms & Conditions as well as the demonstration regulations issued by the Organiser (such documents constitute the unitary legal framework regulating the participation in the Exhibition); b) the obligation to comply with all norms or regulations issued by the Organiser for the sake of the best management of the Exhibition.

7. PAYMENT

As per Art. 6, payment must, without exception, comply with the time schedule and instructions stated in the Registration Form, only through bank transfer and following the details stated in the Application form. An invoice will follow upon receipt of each payment.

To obtain access to the allocated stand, on arrival at the Exhibition, the Exhibitor must present itself at the S.A.T.E. (Exhibitor's Technical Assistance Office) to verify the full settlement of any charges due. Payments for services requested in addition to basic ones provided (Art. 5) must be settled before the opening of the Exhibition. Check-out pass for goods or displays and stand fittings will be issued only after full settlement of any pending debts with the Organiser.

8. CESSATION, WITHDRAWAL, NON PERFORMANCE OF CONTRACTUAL OBLIGATIONS

The cessation , rental, or sub-rental even on a non payment basis, whether for the complete stand or part thereof is expressly forbidden. The exhibitor who is not able to partake in the event or requests a reduction of the exhibition space already allocated must give immediate notice to the Organiser by registered post. In this instance, a 50 % of the total amount due by the Exhibitor will be retained by the Organiser; or the whole due sum if the cancellation is received by the Organiser in the 30 days before the event. Notwithstanding the right to the above, in the case of withdrawal or non fulfilment of the payment terms as stated in article 7, the Organiser has the right to immediately take possession of the area originally allocated.

9. ALLOCATION OF STANDS

The allocation of stands is the exclusive right of the Organiser, considering the following criteria: a) date of submission of the Registration form; b) availability of space and consideration of the layout of the Exhibition; c) participation in previous editions of the Exhibition. All requests expressed by the Exhibitor on submission of the application are merely indicative and can in no case constitute a condition for participation. For technical or general layout reasons the Organiser reserves the right to change the characteristics of the requested and/or initially allocated stand area, with no right for the Exhibitor to any compensation, apart from a proportional reimbursement in case of reduction of the stand area or of its open sides. Notification of any changes will be given by the Organiser at least 8 days before the opening of the Exhibition by registered post. The Organiser can allocate an exhibition surface in areas not currently foreseen by the layout.

10. STAND ASSEMBLING/DISASSEMBLING – STAND ACCESS - DAMAGES

The assembly of the stands must conform to Italian fire prevention, correct wiring (if present) and safety norms. The setting up of the stands must be according to the prior approval of the Organiser. Permits granted and actions undertaken by the Organiser shall not give rise to any liability for whatsoever reason, such liability remaining in all cases with the Exhibitor himself.

Unless otherwise specified, the areas will be made available for stand assembling from September 21st, from 8 am to 7 pm; the stands must be fully set up and ready for display before September 22nd at 5 pm. For the enforcement of safe-work standards, the Organiser will rule the access and the instructions for each exhibitor needing special equipment for the assembly/disassembling period.

Failure to observe the safety rules may result in judicial proceedings.

Stand areas not occupied by 12 pm of this last day shall be considered to have been abandoned and shall remain at the Organiser's full disposal, with no right to any reimbursement. If the stand is set up not in the exact area indicated in the map sent to the Exhibitor with the Notification of stand allocation, the Organiser may, using its own means and without assuming any liability, remove all of the material and charge the Exhibitor with all the expenses and for any damage which might have been caused.

The setting up of any particular structure within the stand area which would cause a notable height infringement (over 3.50 metres) must be communicated with due notice to the organiser who may, according to his unquestionable judgement, give or withhold authorisation to said structure.

The owner and /or authorised personnel of every exhibitor will be granted a non-transferable pass to access to its own stand. It has been decided by the Organiser that 3 (three) passes will be granted to each exhibiting company. These passes are non-transferable to other parties and must be personalised with the name of the exhibiting company. Infringements of these regulations will be subject to a sanction of Euro 50 (fifty) to be paid by the exhibiting company for any misuse of the pass. Any particular needs and requests of the exhibiting companies must be negotiated and agreed upon with the Organiser.

Clearance of the stand area, unless otherwise specified, may not start before September 26th, within working hours 8 am – 7.00 pm, and must be completed by September 27th at 5 pm. Failure to comply with the above shall give the Organiser the right to disassemble the stand and store the materials, without incurring any liability, and at the expense, risk and liability of the defaulting Exhibitor. The materials will be transferred to the General Warehouses of Biella Fiere, where they shall be at the disposal of the legitimate owner. For every day that goods or materials remain in the fairground beyond the deadline for clearance the exhibitor will be charged a penalty of Euro 500 +Vat, provided that the damage for the Organiser is not higher. The Exhibitor shall be held liable for any damage caused to structures and/or equipment of the Organiser and of Fair Centre during its own stand assembling/disassembling, as well as during the Exhibition. Penalty for such damages is Euro 400 +Vat, provided that the damage for the Organiser is not higher. The Exhibitor shall give back to the Organiser stand materials, pieces of furniture and equipment he had on rental, in the same conditions in which they were initially made available to him, apart from the normal wear. Costs for reinstatements, repairing or replacement will have to be paid according to Art. 7.

11. ADDITIONAL TECHNICAL SERVICES – PRESETUP STANDS – WORKING SERVICES PROVIDED

Upon request of the Exhibitor, the Organiser can, within the limits of the plant supplied by the Fair Centre and in accordance with what stated in Mod. B, provide electric energy. The Organiser transfers to the Fair Centre risks and technical obligations arising from these provision contracts. Within limits and conditions set in the forms, on Exhibitor's request, the Organiser may provide fully-equipped stands and the rental of additional pieces of furniture and technical equipment. Pertaining risks and technical obligations are transferred by the Organiser to the contractors concerned to said supplies.

Within organisational possibilities and availability, upon the Exhibitor's request, the Organiser may provide other services such as hosting and others.

12. MACHINERY IN OPERATION - ACCIDENT PREVENTION

With the prior authorisation of the Organiser, machinery on display may be started up, at the Exhibitor's exclusive risk and on condition that: a) no nuisance to nearby Exhibitors or to Visitors due to excessive noise, heat, or vibrations etc. is caused; b) the necessary safety devices and measures in compliance with safety and accident prevention norms are present; c) the exhibitor has adopted all those other measures to ensure the safety of personnel, and of visitors / operators. It is nevertheless the obligation of the exhibitor to ensure that the machinery is equipped with the necessary systems to prevent injury, fire, noise, bad odours, or the emission of gas or liquids. The exhibitor is also held to comply to the tests or regulations laid down by the law in force, in order to obtain from the competent governing authorities the necessary permits. Overhead loads are strictly forbidden.

The Exhibitor has nevertheless the obligation to inform the Organiser, when submitting the Registration Form, of any movement of machinery and the manner thereof. The Organiser reserves, according to its unquestionable judgement, the right to impede the working of such machines which may risk the safety of the Exhibitors or of any of the visitors / operators or cause them excessive nuisance.

13. HANDLING OF LOADS

The Organizer provides, to each exhibitor who applies at the time of need, with a lifting operator (eg, forklift) for the loading - unloading of materials, to be booked by the transporter when the goods arrive at the fair. In any case, the organization is exempt from liability for any irregularities in the service rendered. Forklift service will be provided respecting the order in which it was booked. Forklift service will be available for free from 8 to 12 am and from 1 to 5 pm of September 21, 22, 26 & 27 th, 2011. Exhibitor's staff must be present during this intervention so as to give instructions to the operator so that he can carry out his work safely and effectively. If this is not possible, the Company must necessarily inform the Organiser about his absence and give all the instructions so as to allow the discharge of cargo.

The final positioning of goods in the exhibition space, if not done during the above mentioned timetables, will then be at the Exhibitor's expense. Tariffs will be communicated approximately 15 days before the venue, sent along with the "Exhibitor's Handbook". The operator assigned to the forklift will never proceed on its own initiative to do anything in the absence of the instructions given by staff of the exhibiting company or on its behalf. The Organiser will be entitled to contact the company in case of goods that seem particularly sensitive or unstable, for instructions on how to load - unload. If the Exhibitor has adequate forklifts of their own, they may be used but it will still have to comply with the assembling/disassembling timetables indicated in Art. 10. The Organiser reserves the right to verify eligibility, in all cases declining any responsibility for accidents, malfunctions and / or damage to the structure of the Fair.

14. REPRODUCTIONS OF STANDS - PROPERTY RIGHTS

The stands and the products on display may not be photographed or filmed without the authorisation of the Exhibitor and of the Organiser. The Organiser is not liable for any unauthorised pictures or films taken of stands or goods. The Organiser reserves the right to reproduce or authorise the reproduction of general views or details of the internal and external exhibition areas.

15. ADVERTISING - OFFICIAL PUBLICATIONS

Each Exhibitor may carry out promotional activities only within his own stand and for his own company and those he represents, provided that such activity complies with the law and the other Exhibition regulations. The distribution of catalogues, price lists and other material may be carried out by the Exhibitor exclusively inside his own stand: outside distribution of advertising leaflets is therefore strictly prohibited. Municipal tax for advertising in the stand is included in the Registration fee. Any form of audio-visual promotion/advertising carried out inside the stand is subject to the applicable municipal tax and, in case, to property rights taxes. The Organiser shall print and distribute the Official Catalogue of the Exhibition, without assuming any responsibility for possible omissions or errors. This publication will include information on Exhibitors and the firms represented by them which have been timely registered in the Form A. The Exhibitor can apply for additional advertising space in the Catalogue, at the conditions and the tariffs indicated in the corresponding form. The Organiser reserves the right, without responsibility for any omissions or errors, to print and distribute other publications to illustrate and promote the Exhibition at any time or place. Internet included.

16. SURVEILLANCE - INSURANCE – ORGANISER'S LIABILITY

The Organiser undertakes a general surveillance service over the Exhibition area, but assumes no liability for any theft of or damage to properties displayed in the stands or, in general, laying in the fairground. Each Exhibitor must provide for the surveillance of his own stand during the opening hours of the Exhibition, as well as during assembling and disassembling of the stand.

As specified in Art. 5, the Organiser provides insurance coverage to Exhibitors (general third parties liability) over the entire period ranging from stand construction to disassembling, with a maximum coverage of one Million Euro, covering as from € 250. Should the Exhibitor wish to insure for higher amounts or for further risks, such as theft, he may do so using an insurance company of his choice, at his own expense. The Exhibitor is in any case liable, in civil and criminal law, for any damage to persons or things caused by equipment, structures or whatever else is present in the area allocated to him, as well as for his own acts and those of his staff or collaborators.

The Organiser assumes no liability towards anybody for any noxious fact caused by participants in the Exhibition (whether they are visitors, Exhibitors' staff, contractors, etc.). To comply with safety standards, the premises of the event are similar to places of public entertainment and, therefore, each person must comply with applicable law and to fulfill the provided requirements and formalities.

17. OBLIGATIONS AND PROHIBITIONS - MISCELLANEOUS

In order to safeguard the image of the Exhibition, it is compulsory for every Exhibitor to display/promote only those products/services specified in the Registration form and inside the stand space specifically allocated. To the same end, the following is forbidden: a) to cause disturbances or nuisance of any kind – subject to the judgment of the Organiser - likely to interfere with the smooth running of the Exhibition; b) to leave the stand without surveillance during the opening hours as well as to leave the stand in conditions of evident carelessness during the course of the Exhibition; c) to get out from the fairground any products or materials during the Exhibition without written permission of the Organiser; d) to begin disassembling the stands

before closure of the Exhibition. It is also forbidden to every Exhibitor to use the trademark of the Organiser or of the Exhibition without written authorisation.

The Organiser may terminate his contract with any Exhibitor in breach of these General terms and conditions, the demonstration regulations or other subsequent regulations issued, and exclude him from the Exhibition with immediate closing of the stand. The offender shall have no right to any reimbursement or damages, while the Organiser may take action for the recovery of full damage. For optimal management of the Exhibition the Organiser reserves the right to issue norms and regulations which may differ from those of the General terms and conditions. Such norms and regulations shall have similar force to the present ones and will therefore be equally binding on the Exhibitor. The Italian Civil Code applies to any aspect not covered by the present terms and conditions.

18. VARIATION, REDUCTION, SUPPRESSION OR POSTPONEMENT OF THE EXHIBITION

The Organiser reserves the absolute rights to modify the dates and opening hours of the Exhibition, to reduce the Exhibition or to suppress it partially or completely, as well as to postpone it. Notification of any change shall be given to the Exhibitors at least a month before the opening of the Exhibition by registered post. In case of variation, reduction or suppression of the Exhibition, the Exhibitor has the right to be reimbursed in proportion to the possible non-enjoyment. In no case the Organiser will have to pay indemnities, penalties or damages of any kind.

19. COMPLAINTS - JURISDICTION

Any complaints must be timely presented, in writing, to the Organiser. In the case of dispute and specifically regarding the provisions and the terms & conditions stated herein and/or in any referenced documents, only the Italian texts shall refer (available from the website). Disputes arising between the Exhibitor and Organiser that cannot be settled otherwise will be brought exclusively to the Court in Venice, Italy where the applicable law is Italian law. Paulownia Italia s.r.l., holder of the treatment, manages the personal data provided by the Exhibitor and it's represented companies/brands, also through electronic support, to the purposes concerning the supply of the previously indicated services and, upon the Exhibitor's previous consent, to update about initiatives and offers of the Holder company itself.

The Exhibitor will be able to exercise it's own rights through art. 7 of Legislative Decree 196/2003, (update, rectification, integration, cancellation, transformation – anonymously – of part or the whole of the treated data in violation of law, opposition, request of information of which 1st indention, its letters a), b), c), d), e) and 2^o indention), addressing to Paulownia Italia s.r.l. v.
